
NOT PRINTED MEANS NOT ADOPTED? 1.1.11 Format. This part fundamentally adopts the International Existing Building Code by reference on a chapter-by-chapter basis. When a specific chapter of the International Existing Building Code is not printed in the code and is marked "Reserved", such chapter of the International Existing Building Code is not adopted by the State of California' but appears in the code, it may be available for adoption by local ordinance. Those provisions of the model code used as the basis for this part of the California Building Standards Code in Title 24, Californie-Code of Regulations, that are not-painted Interin and are marked "Not adopted by the State of California," may be available for adoption by local ordinance, provided such-ordinance and related model code provisions to not conflict with Title 24 provisions applicable to the subject occupancy or building feature. Such a local ordinance is not subject to the Express Finding and document filing require-




